FFILM CYMRU FUNDING

DEVELOPMENT

Ffilm Cymru's feature film Development support guides writers, directors and producers through the development process, from treatment to final draft and financing, with tailored advice and funding.

Who can apply?

Either the lead writer, producer or director on the project should be born or based in Wales. Filmmakers should have a strong track record, either in screen work or another narrative art form.

How much can I apply for?

Up to a maximum of £25,000 for a specific stage of development – that could, for example, be initial script work from a treatment, proof-of-concept or packaging costs.



PRODUCTION

Our Production Fund combines National Lottery funds delegated via Arts Council of Wales and Welsh Government funds delegated via Creative Wales.

We want to put Welsh film on the map by nurturing independent Welsh films, which are unconventional, ambitious, and wellcrafted. We particularly want to champion under-represented voices and to push the boundaries of what we know as Welsh film.

Who can apply?

Applicant teams would usually have a track record in the creative industries and have some experience relevant to the role they intend to take on the project they're applying with.

How much can I apply for?

Ffilm Cymru can award up to a maximum of £600,000, but most awards will be in the £150,000 - £400,000 range. We cannot fully finance projects and would ordinarily expect our investment not to exceed 50% of your budget.

SINEMA CYMRU

Sinema Cymru is an exciting new collaboration between S4C, Welsh Government's Creative Wales, and Ffilm Cymru to support Welsh Language feature films with international big screen potential.

Under the Sinema Cymru programme, a minimum of three feature films will be developed a year, with the aim of one of these being selected for production funding.

Who can apply?

Writers, directors or producers who are born or based in Wales.

How much can I apply for?

Teams will be offered up to £30,000 for the development period, with potential for further financial support, and will then have the opportunity to gain a £1 million commission from S4C and up to £600,000 from Creative Wales.

BFI NETWORK WALES

Ffilm Cymru is the Welsh delivery partner of BFI NETWORK, which through National Lottery funding brings together film organisations across the UK to support new and early career filmmakers. This includes funding, professional development and networking for writers, directors and producers.

Funding available through BFI NETWORK Wales includes:

- Short film funding through Beacons, which supports world-class live-action, documentary and animated short films in partnership with BBC Cymru Wales. Filmmakers can apply for up to a maximum £25,000.
- Career development funding for writers, directors and producers towards the cost of activity such as training, mentoring, shadowing or festival/market attendance.
- Funding for organisations to deliver targeted training, networking, research and resources that benefit under-represented filmmaking talent in Wales.







SKILLS

Ffilm Cymru provides targeted training opportunities and resources for people aspiring to work in the film industry or for those looking to further develop their knowledge and skills.

Our award-winning Foot in the Door training programme provides new opportunities for people not currently in employment, education or training. We focus on finding and creating local opportunities for training on film and television productions, where new entrants can develop their transferable skills, such as carpentry, hair and makeup, and costume.

Foot in the Door is at the forefront of Ffilm Cymru Wales' commitment to developing an inclusive and sustainable talent base in Wales, providing film and television companies with a diverse and skilled workforce for their productions.





GREEN


Ffilm Cymru is committed to helping the film industry to reach net zero carbon emissions by 2050. To support this work, we have designed our Green Cymru programme to promote environmental sustainability in Wales' film and TV sector through:

- Developing and signposting resources on best practice, carbon calculators, certification and case studies,
- Encouraging behaviour change through funding conditions and sustainability training,
- Providing funds for new products and services.

GREENING THE SCREEN

Our Greening the Screen Fund will grow products, services and processes to improve the environmental sustainability of the screen sector in Wales. Ffilm Cymru Wales and Media Cymru have partnered on the £600,000 Greening the Screen Fund, and organisations based in the Cardiff Capital Region (CCR) could apply for up to £250,000 to scale-up their work in environmental sustainability.
