Maverick, Mystic, Punk, Ruth will play a pivotal role in the bigger picture, offering an insight into a time of personal and social upheaval, both at home and in the Britain of 1979. Another key figure is Matt's childhood toy, a now-decrepit Snoopy rag doll, who - dressed in a miniature, tailored Teddy Boy suit (styled on The Sex Pistols' Svengali manager Malcolm McLaren) will provoke and elicit honest reflection from the film's director and question his version of events. THE HIPPIES then and now. What truly happened back then and whose side of the story should be told, especially as the film's director is/was the band's ten year-old shoebox drummer? Using archive, music of the period and poetic re-imagining's of key episodes from the past. Working towards a live performance by the re-formed band and cover artistes, the film promises to be an energetic, jarring, comical musical ride through a part-remembered, kaleidoscopically fractured family history, with a visceral, direct, punchy, montaged DIY punk aesthetic.
